SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING A DEPUTY INVOLVED SHOOTING THAT OCCURRED AT THE 3200 BLOCK OF BURTON AVENUE, ROSEMEAD, ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 01, 2008.

DETECTIVES HAVE LEARNED THAT DEPUTIES HAD RESPONDED TO THE 3100 BLOCK OF WALNUT GROVE AVENUE, ROSEMEAD, TO INVESTIGATE A CALL OF AN ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON. UPON THEIR ARRIVAL, THEY HAD CONTACTED THE VICTIM WHO HAD BEEN STABBED MULTIPLE TIMES BY THE SUSPECT WITH A SWORD. DEPUTIES SIMULTANEOUSLY NOTICED THE SUSPECT WAS FLEEING THE SCENE ON FOOT. DEPUTIES IMMEDIATELY CONTAINED THE LOCATION.

A SUBSEQUENT SEARCH FOR THE SUSPECT, LED DEPUTIES TO A RESIDENCE, WHICH IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION, LOCATED ON THE 3200 BLOCK OF BURTON AVENUE, ROSEMEAD. THE SUSPECT HAD SECRETED HIMSELF IN THE SECOND FLOOR BATHROOM OF THE RESIDENCE. AS DEPUTIES APPROACHED THE SECOND FLOOR BATHROOM, THE SUSPECT, WHO WAS ARMED WITH A METAL STAKE, CHARGED AT THE DEPUTIES. THE SUSPECT STRUCK A DEPUTY WITH THE STAKE INJURING HIM. FEARING FOR THEIR SAFETY, DEPUTIES SHOT THE SUSPECT STRIKING HIM IN THE UPPER TORSO.
