Trends

- Targets:
 - Large shopping centers
 - High end designer retail businesses
 - West side of Los Angeles and San Fernando Valley.
- Suspects:
 - Concealing themselves with hoods, masks, and are wearing gloves.
 - Using vehicles with no license plates or paper plates.
 - Some are associated with criminal street gangs.
 - Bear spray in one incident.
 - Use tools to force access by breaking glass windows and display cases.

Enforcement Efforts

- Immediate investigative response.
- Increased communication with surrounding police department partners.
- Increased additional law enforcement saturation to other shopping facilities.
- Immediate response by Detective Division.
- Working with local and federal partners to identify and locate potential suspects.
- Strategy of aggressive filing for prosecutorial consideration.
- Surveillance of high priority target areas.
- Mounted and uniformed units assigned to targeted areas as a visible deterrent.
- Dedicated helicopter unit assigned to primary target areas.

Prevention Strategies

- Encourage "See something, Say Something" approach to report potential criminal activity.
- Encourage the installation of additional lighting and surveillance cameras.
- Encourage business owners to move expensive merchandise away from doors.
- Encourage business owners to work with law enforcement by sharing information about potential suspects and addressing security vulnerabilities.
