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CONDITIONS OF CONFINEMENT- 2023 QUARTER TWO REPORT

Efforts to Reduce the Jail Population

Los Angeles Sheriff's Department (LASD) continues to utilize various methods to manage the inmate population, including but not limited to leaving the misdemeanor bail admitted at 50K, having been raised from 25K; applying accelerated releases for all inmates by 30 days using CA Penal Code 4024.1 PC; keeping the percentage release at 10% of their court ordered sentences; and releasing non-violent, non-serious, non-sexual charges and the short sentences at 240 days. On May 23, 2023, zero bail was re-implemented, which helped divert inmates that would have otherwise entered the County Jail system. LASD has been working with California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to coordinate the transfer of inmates sentenced to state prison. The number of inmates waiting for transfer to CDCR (SP – SP4) has dropped significantly from 1,171 in the beginning of January, to 1,048 during the first quarter and currently down to 600 SP-SP4 inmates. Quarter 1 had 233 SP4 inmates which is now at 145 SP4, with their paperwork processed and pending transfer to CDCR.

Additionally, LASD has been working with the State Hospitals in trying to reduce the number of inmates awaiting transfer to State Hospitals. At the beginning of January, there were 593 inmates awaiting transfer to State Hospitals which was reduced during the first quarter to 353 inmates. Most recent numbers reflect a slight increase to 439. LASD continues to collaborate with the Courts, District Attorney's Office, and Probation Department's office on felony bail deviation for the release of medically vulnerable individuals due to COVID-19.

Ongoing reassessments are conducted to identify appropriate housing and to mitigate any unnecessary operational delays.

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Efforts to Mitigate Communitive Diseases (Hepatitis A Case Response)

Situation: CHS infection control personnel were informed on 5/30/2023 of a patient from CJ who had been sent to LA General Medical Center and had tested positive for an acute hepatitis A infection on 5/28/2023. On 5/31/2023, it was confirmed that the patient had been a trustee assigned to the CJ kitchen.

CHS Response: CHS identified all individuals who had been housed in CJ during the infectious period of the patient, noted their current locations, procured a large supply of Hepatitis A vaccines as post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP), and mobilized a team to prepare for mass vaccination. Patients without documented Hepatitis A immunity and/or Hepatitis A vaccination records were prioritized to receive PEP. Between 6/2/2023 and 6/12/2023, a total of 2,763 Hepatitis A vaccines were offered, and a total of 1,507 individuals were agreeable to receive the vaccine. Refusals were documented in the EHR and investigated further if they reported an external history of vaccination. Refusals for whom vaccination histories could not be verified were approached for vaccination a second time, and if they continued to refuse and were identified as kitchen trustees, they were removed from kitchen duties.

Conclusion and Ongoing efforts: To date, no additional cases of acute Hepatitis A have been identified among CHS patients. Surveillance is ongoing, consisting of 1) the routine surveillance conducted by CHS Communicable Disease and Surveillance staff for positive Hepatitis A IgM antibody results and 2) examining CHS emergency referral reasons related to jaundice or hepatitis.
