

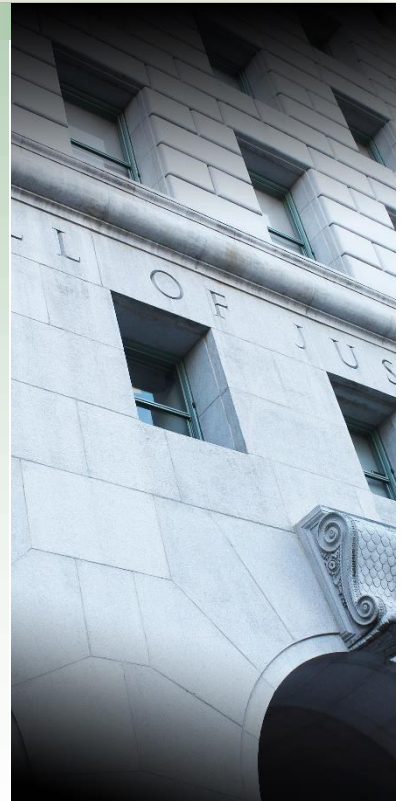

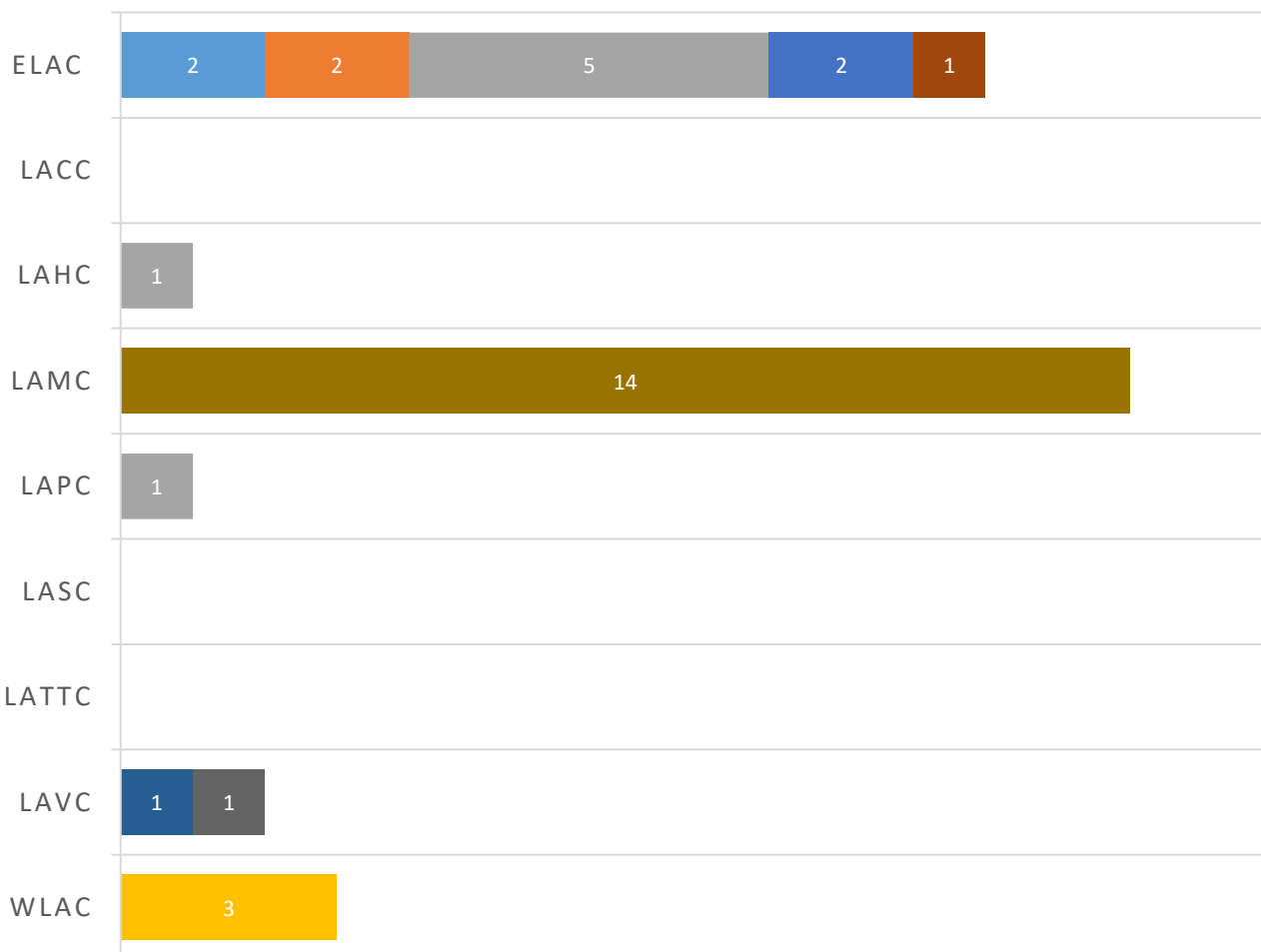
## Community College Bureau (cont.)

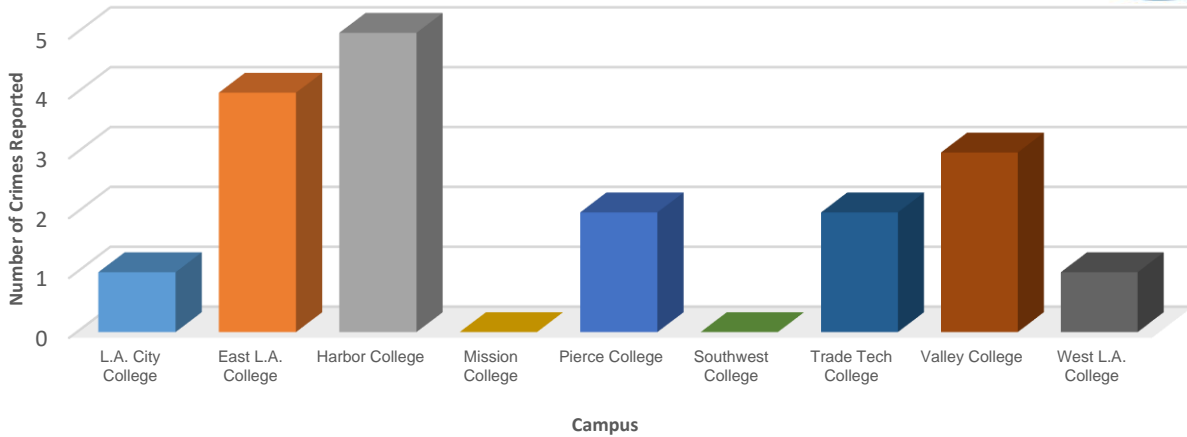

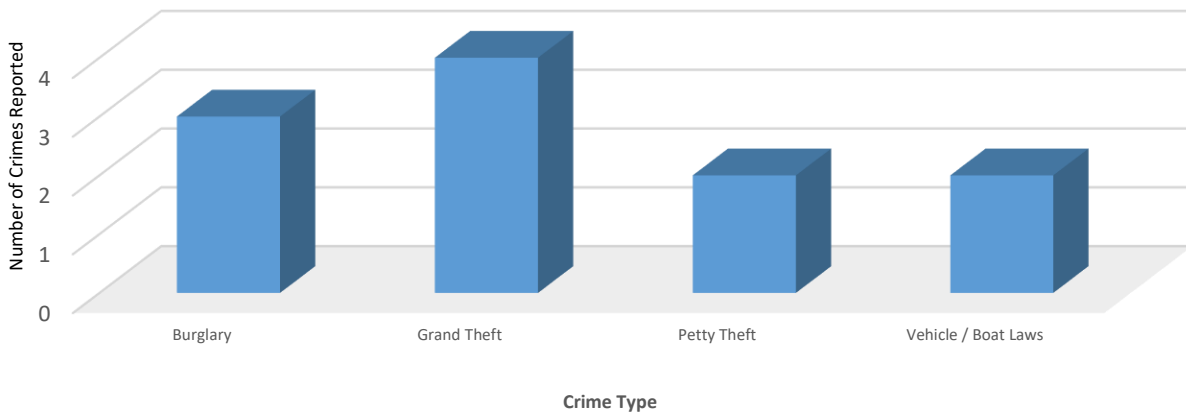

Total Part I & II By Campus

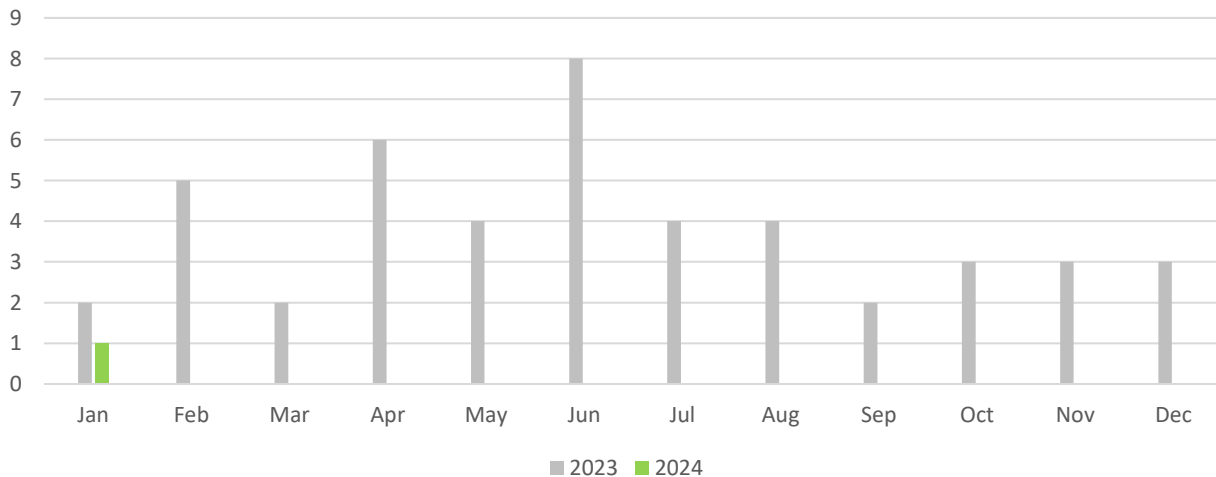

## Year-to-Date Arrests by Month

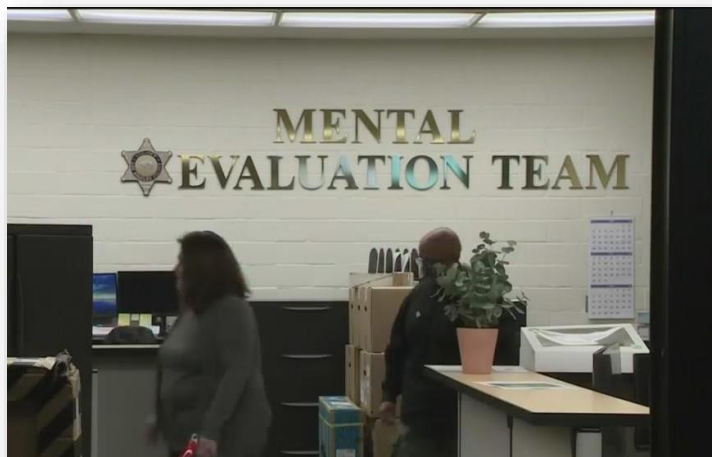

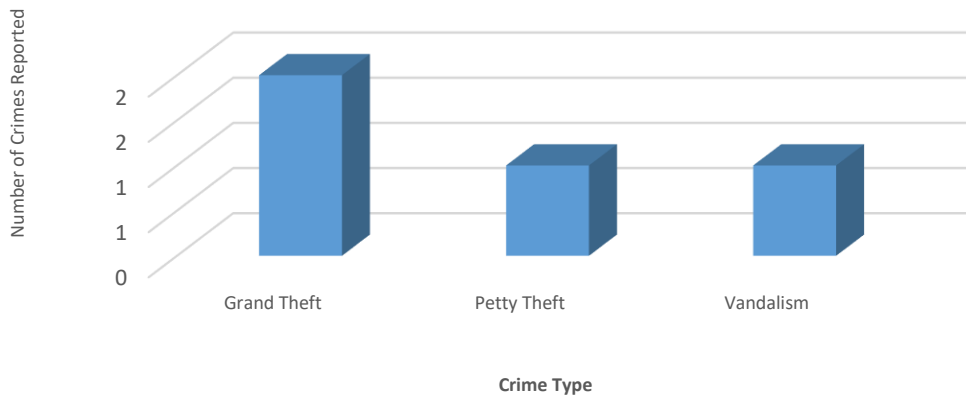
East Los Angeles College (ELAC) had four crimes reported in the month of January and no arrests.

# Los Angeles Harbor College



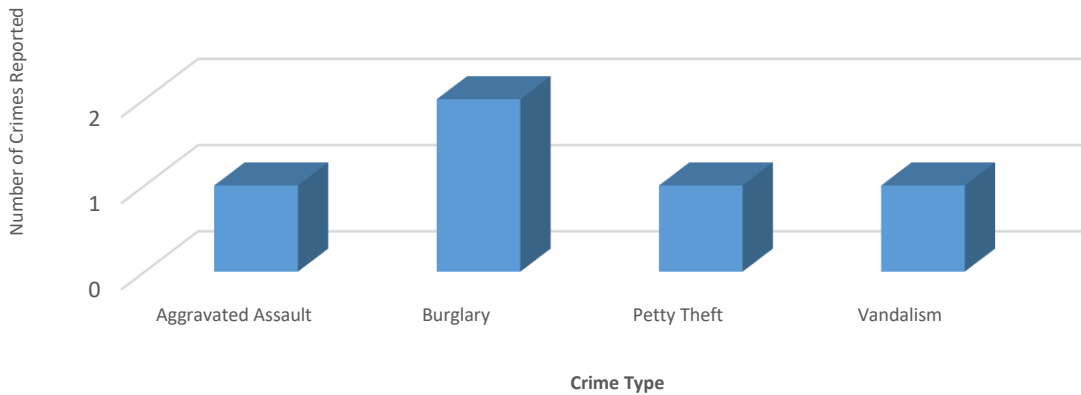

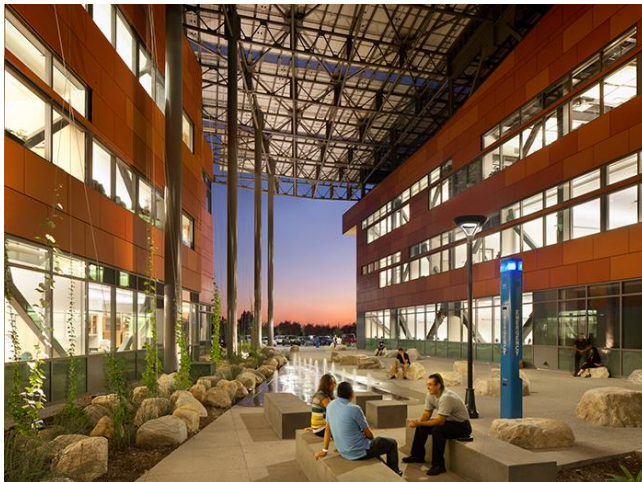
There were no crimes and no arrests reported for the month of January at Los Angeles Mission College (LAMC).
