

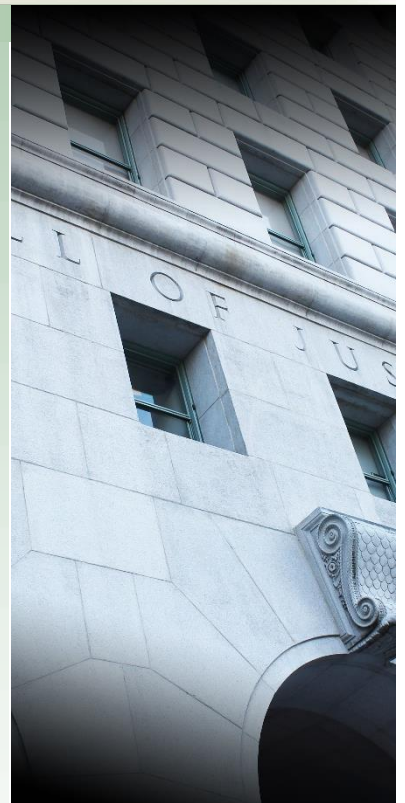

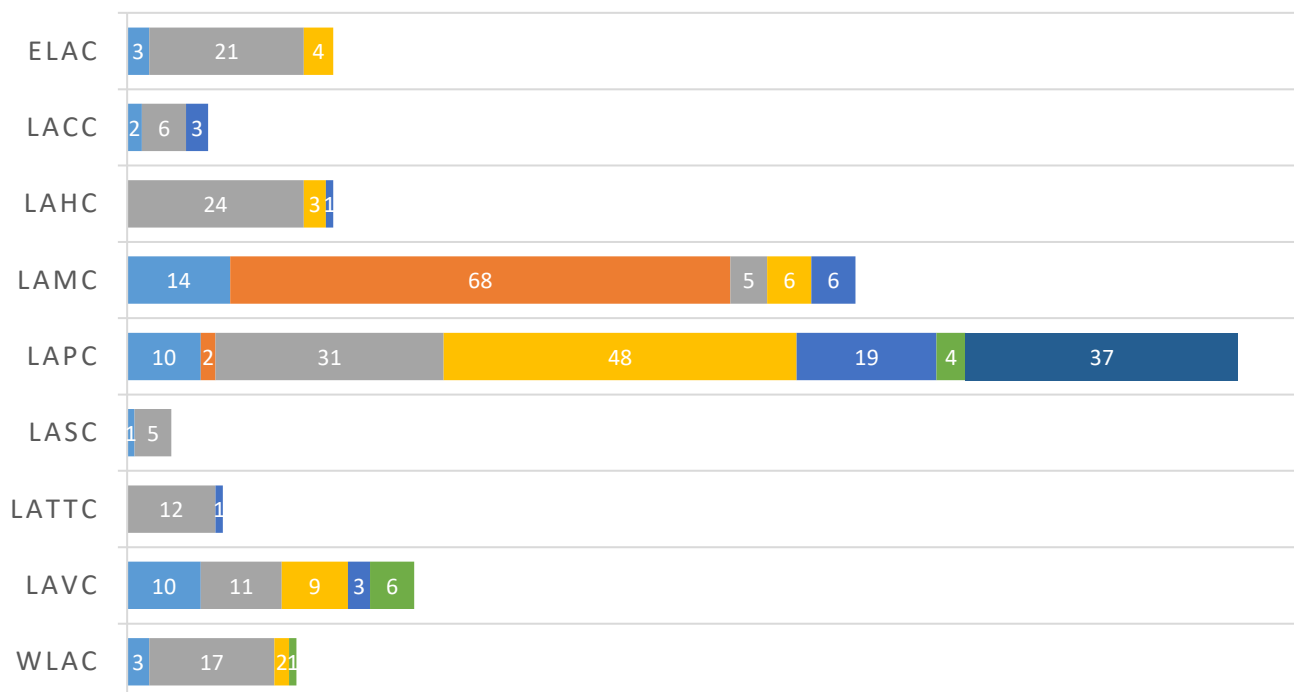
Community College Bureau (cont.)

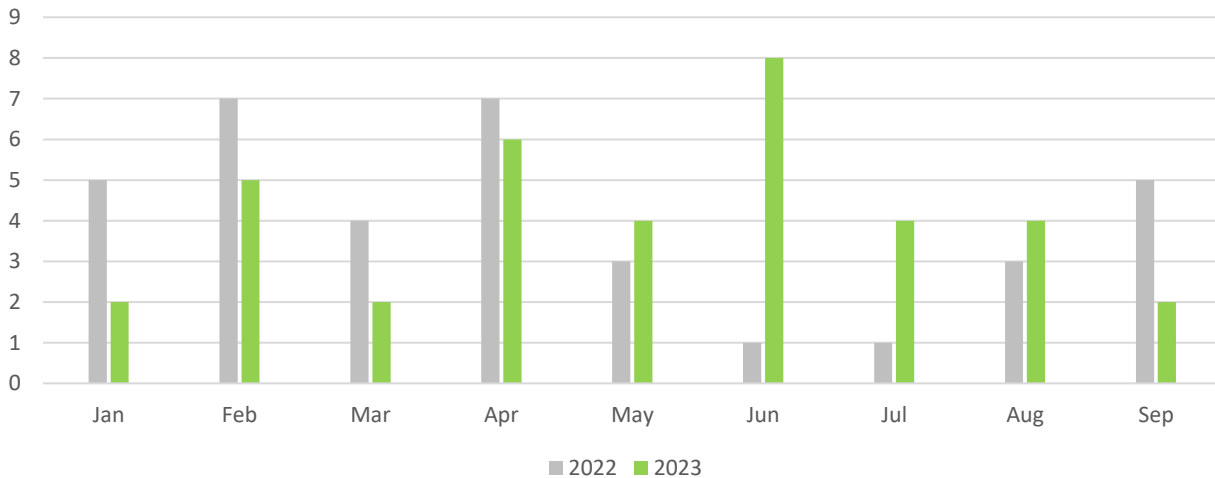

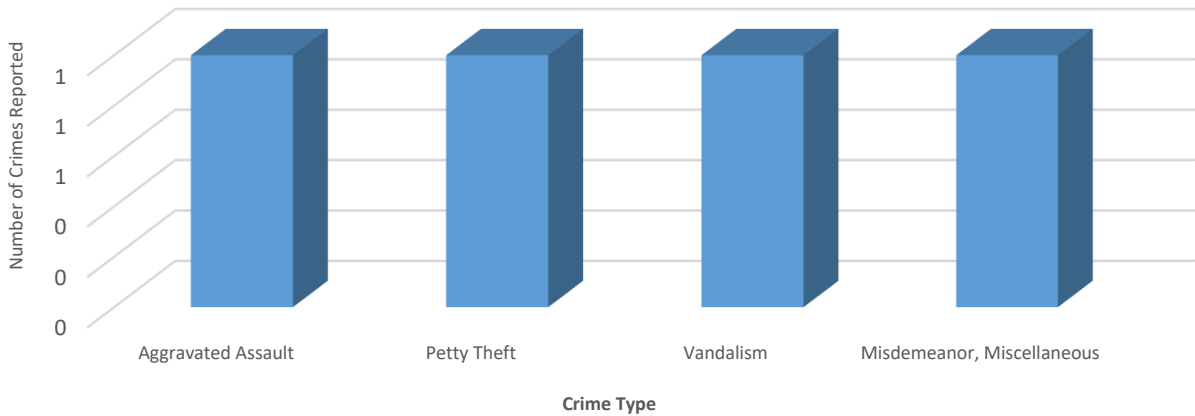
ELAC had four crimes reported in the month of September and one arrest. A male (unknown if student) was arrested for burglary.

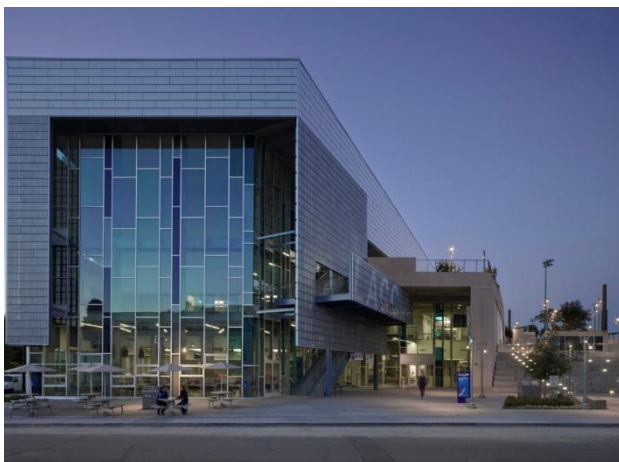
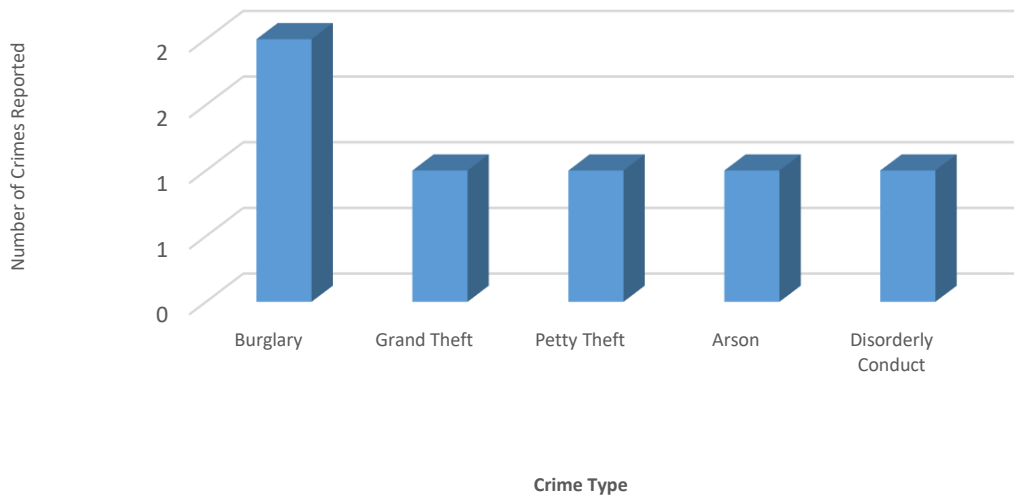
LACC had six crimes reported in the month of September and one arrest. A male (unknown if student) was arrested for felony burglary.

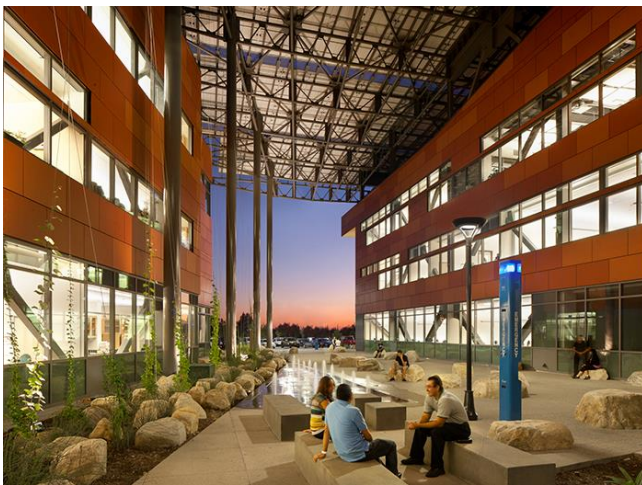
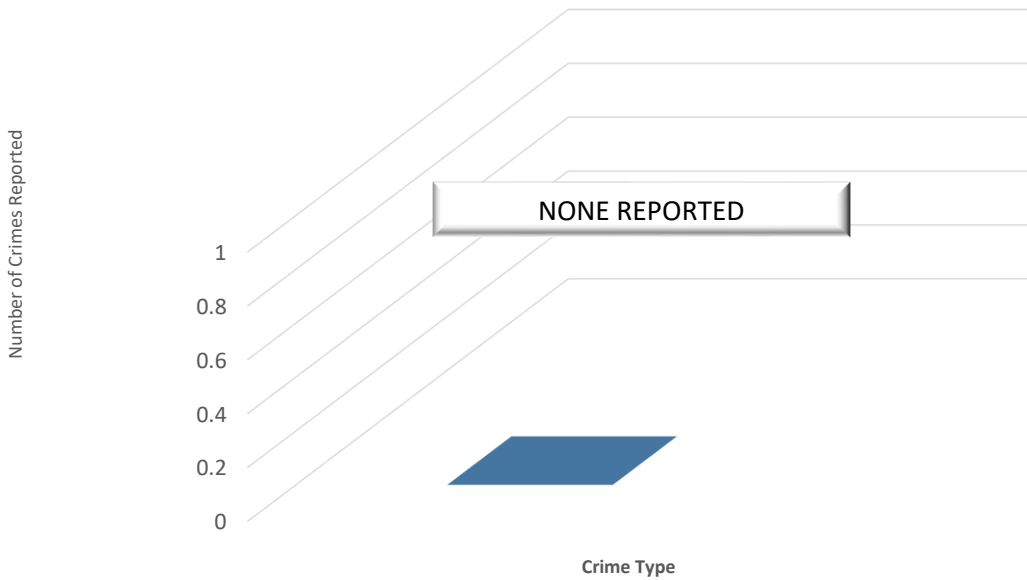
There was no crimes or arrests reported for the month of September at LAMC.

LAPC had three crimes reported in the month of September and no arrests.

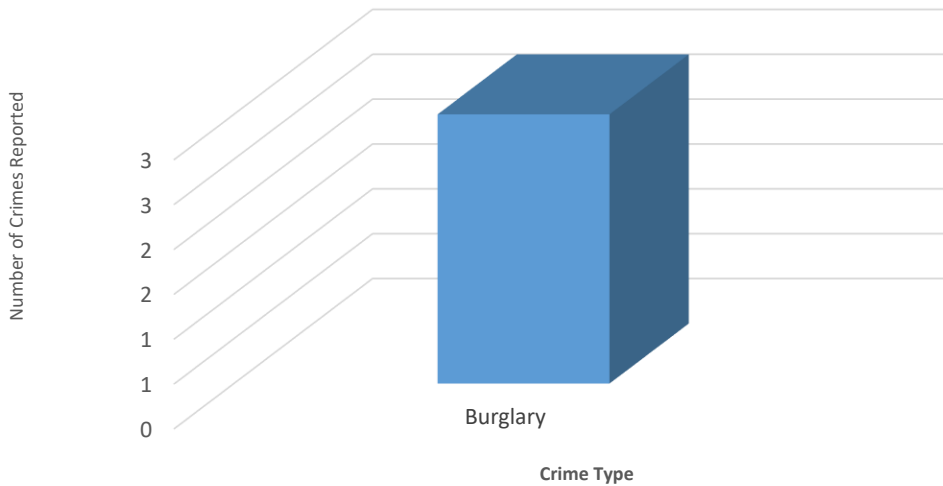
