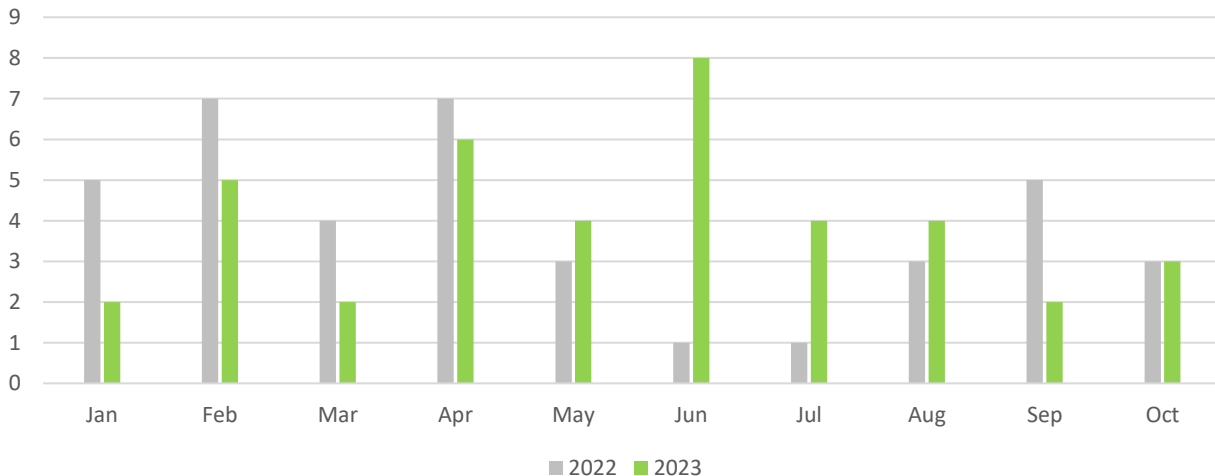

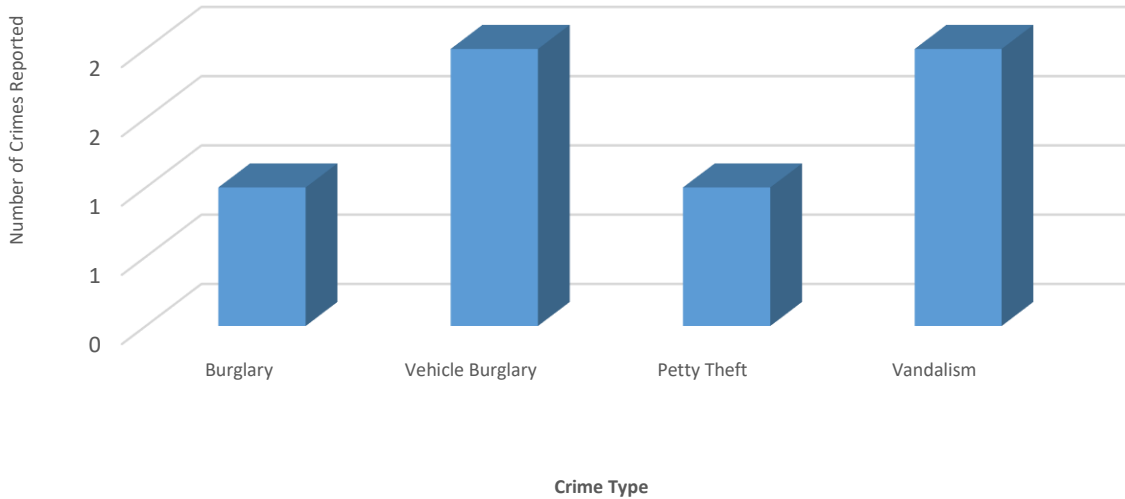
Los Angeles Harbor College (LAHC) had six crimes reported and no arrests in the month of October.

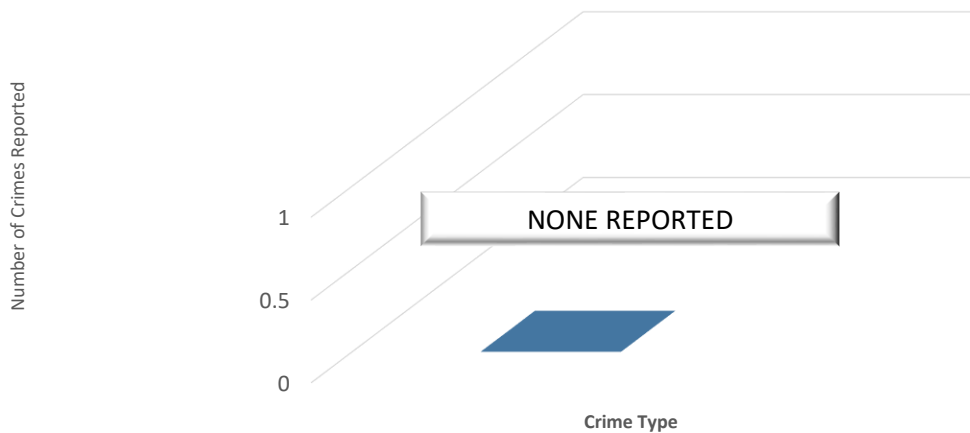
There were no crimes or arrests reported for the month of October at Los Angeles Mission College (LAMC).

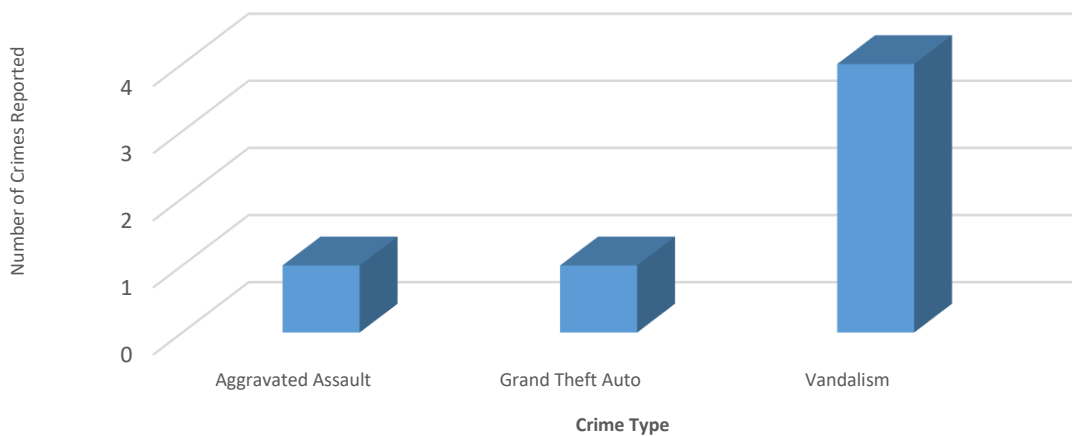
Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) had six crimes reported for the month of October and one arrest. A male (unknown if student) was arrested for graffiti vandalism.
