

Reported use of Kinetic Energy Projectiles and/or Chemical Agents for crowd control as specified in CA Penal Code section 13652.

Incident Date: June 7, 2025

The following is a crowd control incident summary as required under CA Penal Code section 13652.1.

Summary

On June 7, 2025, the Sheriff's Response Team (SRT) was activated and deployed for anti-immigration protests taking place throughout Los Angeles County. An unlawful assembly was declared in the area of Alondra Blvd and Atlantic Ave, Compton. SRT personnel began initiating dispersal orders in English and Spanish using amplified sound. The announcements included a safe route to disperse and leave the area and what type of force may be used for those who refused to disperse. The announcements continued throughout the deployment in an attempt to gain voluntary compliance.

Justification for use

In response to fireworks, rocks, bottles, explosives (commercial grade fireworks), Molotov cocktails, and other injurious items being thrown at SRT personnel, illegal street takeovers, and failures to disperse. Multiple injurious objects, Molotov cocktails, and explosives (commercial grade fireworks) were thrown toward SRT personnel, violating 245 (c) and 18740 Penal Codes.
