Efforts to Reduce the Jail Population

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Department (LASD) continues to utilize various methods to manage the inmate population, including but not limited to, leaving the misdemeanor bail admitted at 50K, having been raised from 25K; applying accelerated releases for all inmates by 30 days using CA Penal Code 4024.1 PC; keeping the percentage release at 10% of their court ordered sentences for non-violent charges; and releasing short sentences if they are less than 240 days and non-violent charges.

On October 1, 2023, Pre-Arrest Release Protocols (PARP) was implemented and assisted in diverting additional incarcerated individuals who would have otherwise entered the Los Angeles County jail system.

LASD continues to work with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to coordinate the transfer of incarcerated individuals sentenced to state prison. The number of incarcerated individuals awaiting transfer to CDCR (SP-SP4) decreased from an average of 620 in the first quarter of 2025 to 588 in the second quarter. During the third quarter, there was a slight increase to an average of 602 individuals awaiting transfer. The third quarter average of 602 SP-SP4 incarcerated individuals awaiting transfer represented approximately 5% of the total incarcerated population.

The number of incarcerated individuals sentenced to state prison has stabilized as LASD has sustained the number of newly sentenced state prisoners, and there is no backlog. As of September 30th, there were 113 SP4 incarcerated individuals (all paperwork is processed) pending transfer to CDCR.

LASD continues to work with state hospitals to reduce the incarcerated population. During the third quarter of 2025, the average population of incarcerated individuals with medical needs was 68, which amounts to a 43% year-over-year decrease and represents approximately 1% of the total incarcerated population.

LASD continues to collaborate with the Office of Diversion and Reentry (ODR) on diverting qualified incarcerated individuals to ODR releases, who otherwise would have gone to state hospitals.
