School Resource Deputy Program Statistics

The SRD program utilizes two statistical codes to differentiate a program response vs a station response. 801 is used for criminal contact by a School Resource Deputy; 802 is used by the School Resource Deputies for non-criminal contacts.

In Quarter 1 2025, criminal contacts by a School Resource Deputy accounted for 17.26% of all calls entered by the deputies. A breakdown of call clearance code by month and station is shown below. **Please note this is not a count of the number of contacts, but of the number of incidents.

Note: Review of PLM 801 stat code clearances showed the 801 code was being used for non-criminal contacts. The number of criminal contacts for the months of July were 1, August were 1, and September were 29. Newly assigned deputies from PLM attended an 8-hour SRD training at the end of September and preliminary data for October shows contacts are being logged appropriately.
