

MET MENTAL EVALUATION TEAM

The purpose of the Los Angeles County Mental Evaluation Team (MET) is to provide compassionate field intervention and appropriate placement in situations involving Sheriff's deputy contacts with citizens suffering from mental health disorders or suspected mental illnesses within the County of Los Angeles.

Since 1991 the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the Department of Mental Health have collaborated and developed the Mental Evaluation Team

A deputy is partnered with a mental health clinician for field response. MET personnel are trained professionals in the evaluation of mentally ill persons, identification of these persons when necessary, and locating appropriate placement.

The combining of these two (2) agencies has created a team with a much needed expertise and resources.
