Subject: Request for Subject Matter Expert (SME) and Presentation

The Los Angeles County Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission (Commission) will be hosting a virtual forum titled "**ICE-y Conditions: Know Your Rights and Navigate the Law.**" The event will take place virtually on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Chair Hans Johnson requests the participation of Daniel Delgadillo from the Office of Constitutional Policing and/or designee to offer five (5) minutes of prepared remarks with no more than five (5) PowerPoint slides, followed by moderated discussion, on the following topics:

1. The role of constitutional policing principles in the context of immigration enforcement interactions in Los Angeles County.
2. How the Department ensures adherence to constitutional standards, including due process, equal protection, and appropriate jurisdictional boundaries.
3. Clarification of the public's right to film law enforcement officers in public spaces, provided that individuals do not interfere with lawful law enforcement activities.
4. Guidance for community members on what constitutes lawful observation and documentation versus interference.

The Commission believes that participation from LASD is essential to ensuring a balanced, informative, and constructive dialogue. LASD's perspective will help promote public understanding of departmental policies and reinforce shared commitments to constitutional governance and community trust.
