Efforts to Reduce the Jail Population

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Department (LASD) continues to utilize various methods to manage the inmate population, including but not limited to, maintaining the misdemeanor bail at \$50,000 (increased from \$25,000); applying accelerated releases for all inmates by 30 days pursuant to California Penal Code 4024.1; keeping the percentage release at ten percent of their court ordered sentences for non-violent charges; and releasing inmates with non-violent charges and short sentences of less than 240 days.

On October 1, 2023, Pre-Arrest Release Protocols (PARP) was implemented and assisted in diverting additional incarcerated individuals who would have otherwise entered the Los Angeles County jail system.

LASD continues to work with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to coordinate the transfer of incarcerated individuals sentenced to state prison. During the first quarter of 2026, 489 incarcerated individuals were awaiting transfer to CDCR (SP – SP4). This represented approximately four percent of the total incarcerated population.

The number of incarcerated individuals sentenced to state prison has stabilized, as LASD has sustained the number of newly sentenced state prisoners, and there is no backlog. As of March 31, 2026, there were 98 SP4 incarcerated individuals (all paperwork processed) pending transfer to CDCR.

LASD continues to work with state hospitals coordinating and quickly transferring inmates sentenced to go to state hospitals. During the first quarter of 2026, the average population of incarcerated individuals waiting to be transferred to state hospitals was 81, which amounts to a four percent year-over-year increase and represents approximately one percent of the total incarcerated population.

LASD continues to collaborate with the Office of Diversion and Reentry (ODR) on diverting qualified incarcerated individuals to ODR releases, who otherwise would have gone to state hospitals.
